

Halesworth & District Museum Museum Friends Application for 2018 – 2019

The Friends of the Halesworth and District Museum have provided help to our Museum over many years with support in the form of ideas, practical effort and resources. Membership of the Friends runs from April to March. We do hope that you will renew your membership again for the year 2018/2019.

The annual subscription is £7 per person, and you may wish to add an additional donation which will create a reserve fund to allow the Museum to purchase items which are deemed to be of particular local interest. For example, we are often offered by the British Museum, archaeological objects found in our area and there were other items we recently purchased from an auction. We have heard that a significant hoard may soon be offered to us by the British Museum.

The last few months there has been major remedial work undertaken to stop the damp problems at our end of the station, which were paid for by the Town Council. This has meant that the Museum has been closed for a protracted period. However we will be starting the season with a number of new displays: "They paid the price ... men from Halesworth killed in the Great War"; "The British Red Cross in Halesworth & District 1914-1918", and "The de Argenteins, Lords of Halesworth Manor". In the near future we will be having a new cabinet for the Wissett Hoards and a revised Geology display showing some of the erratics found in the area.

The museum is in the process of finalising "The de Argentein Family; Cup-bearers to Medieval Kings", the de Argenteins were Lords of Halesworth Manor in the medieval period.

Due to the work being undertaken, we have not had our usual brochure printed yet, however here are some dates for your diary:

- 17/04/2018: Museum 'soft' opening. Not all the exhibits will be ready immediately, but will be finalised soon after.
- 19/04/2018: Museum Talk – John Debenham: Local Archaeology.
- 07/05/2018: Special Opening of the Museum; all exhibits will be set up, including the Wissett Hoards.
- 24/05/2018: Museum Talk – Dave Wollweber: The Strange Carvings on the Ancient House.

More information will be of these and other events will be sent out in newsletters.
